



HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF ETCHELLS FLEET 20

A. First - join the International Etchells class and the US National class:

- 1. Go to the Etchells North American website: https://etchellsna.com/
- 2. Click on "Register for the Class"
- 3. Enter the required data as either a New Member or Previous Member
- 4. In the Local Fleet # box enter: "Fleet 20 Biscayne Bay"
- 5. For an Active Member (Skipper or Owner) the fee for both the International Etchells Class Association and the US Etchells Class is \$ 220
- 6. Note: You can also sign up all your crew as Associate Member(s) for \$55 per Associate while you are signing yourself up
- 7. Please save your email confirmation of IECA and US Etchells Class membership.
- 8. Once you have finished registering for the International Etchells class and the US National class you need to join Fleet 20.

B. Then - join Etchells Fleet 20:

- 1. PAYPAL. Go to www.paypal.com. If you a not registered, you must sign up.
 - a. Go to the SEND tab and enter Payment@EtchellsFleet20.Org
 - b. Enter your payment amount. \$100.00 for Skipper and optional \$40.00 for each crew.
 - c. In the 'What's This For' box put:
 - "Skipper Name, Sail Number, Etchells Fleet 20 Dues 2024, Plus crew names".
 - d. Click Send.
 - e. Please save your email confirmation of Fleet 20 membership

2. Or send a check.

You can send a check and paper application to Jonah Pruitt at 401 Cadima Ave, Coral Gables, FL 33134. You can download the application from the Etchells Fleet 20 site at www.etchellsfleet20.org Go to the Fleet 20 Information tab and download the application form. You may also turn check and application into the Registration Desk on Feb 2 and 3 when you register.

C. Total Fleet 20 Dues:

- a. Active Member (Skipper or Owner): \$220 (IECA AND US) + \$100 (Fleet 20) = \$320
- b. Associate Member: \$55 (IECA AND US) + \$40 (Fleet 20) = \$95

Note: You can follow the same procedure to register and sign up your crew later.

For the Florida State Championship Regatta, all Skipper/Owners must be Active Members of the IECA and US National class. To be eligible for the Florida State Championship Perpetual trophy, all Skipper/Owners must also be members of Fleet 20.
